Proof of qualified energy property for claiming tax credits for residential heat pump water heaters

The American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 extended the period in which the section 25C tax credit can be claimed for purchasing certain energy efficient property for use in existing homes, including a retroactive provision for certain purchases made in calendar year 2012.

GE GeoSpring® heat pump water heaters have an EF rating of 2.35, which makes them qualified for a tax credit of \$300.

GE Appliances certifies that the model(s) listed below (if purchased and installed between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2013 in a homeowner's principal residence) meets the criteria of "Qualified Energy Property" as set forth by Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code.
